### National Water Resources Framework Study



CEEW led a team of five senior experts to coordinate a National Water Resources Framework Study for the Planning Commission of India. The study covered large scale irrigation, groundwater management, river basin planning, urban water supply, and regulatory and legal reforms. It is also developing roadmaps for reforms for

the 12th Five Year Plan and beyond.

### India-U.S. Joint Clean Energy R&D Centre (JCERDC)



Announced in November 2010, the JCERDC is a promising initiative for joint R&D collaborations covering solar, second generation biofuels and energy efficiency in buildings. CEEW partnered with the U.S. Natural Resources Defense Council and the Administrative Staff College of India to organise consultations and give

inputs on programme design.

### Governance of Geoengineering



CEEW is collaborating with the UK's Royal Society, the Academy of Sciences for the Developing World, and the US's Environmental Defense Fund to outline concerns regarding and options on how to govern geoengineering technologies. Dr Arunabha Ghosh delivered a keynote lecture to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change in June 2011.

### Maharashtra-Guangdong Partnership on Sustainability



In October 2010, CEEW was instrumental in creating a partnership on sustainability between these two major provinces in India and China, respectively. The partnership aims to establish a dialogue among policymakers, undertake joint research projects, and bring industry representatives together.
