
## Navigating the Infrastructure Investment Current with InvITs

An infrastructure investment trust (InvIT) raises funds from the unit-holders and invests in infrastructure assets, such as solar and wind power projects.



Funds are invested in the form of equity (at least 51%) and debt (can only be extended in case of equity holdings). At least 80% of the funds are invested in operational assets, which include physical projects, Special Purpose Vehicles (SPVs) or Holding companies.
